

1. Minutes of previous meeting were read and confirmed.
2. Correspondence received:
 - (a) Waterside Workers - suggest arrange a meeting with them and discuss exhibition on waterfront.
 - (b) Festival of all Nations - (co-ordinator was present at meeting and sought ideas and help from CAW). Vito said that there should be more activities for kids and expressed dissatisfaction at the way the festival had been organised in the past. It is essentially for all sections of ethnic community to come together. He said that it might be possible a wall to be provided for CAW to do a mural on. It was decided that a date be set for people interested in helping with the festival to meet Vito and discuss this. Monday at 8 (Oct. 11) was set.

Various correspondence was received from people interested in CAW, they had been included in the mail out and invited to this meeting.

3. Treasurer's Report - \$150 approx. in bank, \$50 received from exhibition at RMIT. The name of the account is to be changed to CAW. There was an appeal for 20¢ per meeting to be donated by those present to cover our mail outs.
4. 3CR report was read out, asking for more help with programmes and detailing those which have been made since the last meeting. Notes on meeting of affiliated groups' representatives were read out. It was affirmed that a call for walls for students at Preston had been broadcast several times on 3CR. The persons who asked for this to be done were not at the meeting so there was no indication whether this had been successful.
5. Report on Womens Exhibition - exhibition is on October 30 and there is still time for more contributions. Written material by women is also acceptable.
6. Gertrude Street Mural - to be on wall of Aboriginal Medical Centre. There will be an art and craft workshop on Tuesday at 8, 181 Gertrude St., Fitzroy. Interested members of CAW invited.
7. Float - good progress is being made. Fund raising party proposed?
8. Fund raising party also proposed for CAW but no decision was arrived at.
9. Childrens Book Report - proposed children's story was discussed by members CAW and PAGE on writing and illustrating two children's books:
 - i for pre school children
 - ii for 15 year olds - history of class struggle in Australia.Another meeting to discuss this is on Wed. Oct. 13 for interested people.
10. It was decided that the venue for the next meeting be the Edelweiss Restaurant.
11. Loose Licks - people to prepare statement of the work they are doing for the next meeting, to be written up in this publication.
12. Cartoon - a cartoon was circulated and it was proposed that we re do it in political context.
